

This document provides a list of planned changes for the 2022-23 SUDS collection cycle that is a part of the planning process. This document incorporates the discussions from the March 2022 Council of Data Administrators (CODA) quarterly meeting. The Software Release Notes, that are part of every software release, remain the official documentation of all changes to SUDS software.

- ODA will continue to review all static SAS reports within SUDS submissions and either terminate outdated reports, or transform to dynamic SQL reports.
- ODA will review all level 5 diagnostic edits and either terminate outdated/non-essential edits, transform to level 8/9 edits if applicable, or make no changes to level 5 edits.

Effective 3/5/2021, all submission builds happen entirely in PROD, and the BETA tier is no longer used to load data prior to PROD. To help you preload your data builds, ODA has added 'optional' terms for several submissions that will enable universities to begin your builds before we release the next year's software. The submission button has been deactivated for any 'optional' submissions, so the preliminary data cannot be submitted by mistake. **It is important to note that the software for the optional terms for the annual submissions (IRD, HTD) may change when the next year's software is officially released.**

The UID was added to EMPL/SCD tables on the 2021-22 software and the UID is becoming a LUK key for EMPL/SCD tables in the 2022-23 software. The UID will become LUK on the other remaining tables in the software in Year2 or Year3.

Over the next few years, ODA will work to integrate the UID into the SYSID assignment process.

Coding Instructions

<u>Current</u>: For all student related submissions, report the primary identifier that is used to identify a student. For all employee related submissions (SCD, EMPL, IRD), report the primary identifier that is used to identify an employee.

<u>Revised</u>: For all submissions, report the primary identifier that is used to identify a person at your institution. A person should only ever have one UNIV_ID at an institution.

Effective with the 2022-23 software, there are five level X diagnostic edits that are designed to check that UNIVIDs match across all the tables <u>within</u> a submission – one new edit (#5411) and three existing edits (#0007, #5408, #5407) are being applied to new tables. Edit 5410 was added to the IRD in the 2021-22 release and is not being applied to anything new this year, but is included here so this table is a comprehensive summary of all of the edits related to UNIVID.

PERSON_ID (#1029): Revise Coding Instructions and add a new edit.

Description

A nine digit number assigned to an individual for identification purposes.

Coding Instructions

New Student/Applicant

- If the new student/applicant's identification number conforms to the Social Security Number format, then the number can be used as the PERSON_ID (#01029) and the PID_VALID_SSN (#02017) should be coded 'Y'. See the PID_VALID_SSN element for more information about how the validity of SSNs is determined.

- If the new student/applicant's identification number does not conform to the Social Security Number format, then the non-conforming number should not be used as the PERSON_ID (#01029). Instead, the UNIV_ID (#01095) should be used (translated into a nine-digit alpha-numeric string with no more than two alpha characters) and the PID_VALID_SSN (#02017) should be coded 'N'. If your institution assigns each student with a distinct University Row Identifier (#02002) that serves as a unique student id across all submissions, then ROWID may be used instead of the UNIVID.

Note: Most international students are eligible to apply for a Social Security Number if they are employed or are receiving financial aid. International students who are not eligible for a Social Security Number might have an Individual Taxpayer Identification Numbers (ITIN) from the Internal Revenue Service. However, the ITIN should not be used as the PERSON_ID because the ITIN is not a permanent identification number and students can receive multiple ITINs over the years.

Returning Student/Applicant

- We expect returning students/applicants to have the same PERSON_ID that was reported previously. However, if the returning student/applicant, who previously had been assigned a PERSON_ID where PID_VALID_SSN='N', has recently provided a different ID number that does conform to the Social Security Number format, then the newly conforming ID number should be reported as the PERSON_ID moving forward and PID_VALID_SSN should be coded 'Y'. See the *important* note below about providing PERSON_ID_CHGS records.

IMPORTANT NOTES

ID Changes: If you have previously reported an individual under a different PERSON_ID on any submission, then you will need to use the new PERSON_ID on all tables for the current submission and submit a PERSON_ID_CHGS record in the current submission with both the old and new PERSON_IDs. This is required for SUDS to create accurate SYSID.

When you submit a PERSON_ID_CHGS record the following diagnostic edit will ensure that you are not reporting a new temporary PERSON_ID to replace the previous temporary PERSON_ID: "PERSON ID VALID (#02017) must equal 'Y' unless PERSON_ID (#1029) equals University Identifier (#1095) or PERSON_ID (#1029) equals University Row Identifier (#02002)."

Grandfathered Records: We are not requiring ID changes for returning students/applicants who previously had been assigned a PERSON_ID where PID_VALID_SSN='N' and the PERSON_ID does not match the UNIV_ID (#1095) or the ROWID (#02002).

Cohort Adjustment Flag (#1442): Clarify rules for the Q adjustment in the coding instructions RET and revise the definition for the Q adjustment. **Coding Instructions CURRENT**: blank **REVISED:** The 'Q' value should be used when: (1) A student is found to have previously earned a bachelor's degree prior to their most recent admission at your institution and are in fact a post-baccalaureate student who failed to notify your institution about their previous bachelor's degree on their admission transcripts. (2) A student has multiple cohort years for the same cohort type at the same institution and campus code. The Retention software does not allow a student to have multiple cohort years for the same cohort type at the same institution and campus code. Some students might have multiple Date Most Recent Admission (#1420), with the same Type Of Student At Time Of Most Recent Admission (#1413), on their SIF submissions; however, the Retention software has procedures to delete (later) records when a student has the same cohort type, but multiple cohort years at the same institution/campus. --(2.1) Occasionally ID change issues will cause the Retention software to miss a student having multiple cohort years within a single cohort type and the student will be incorrectly placed into multiple cohort years with the same cohort type. When this happens, the Institutional Data

Administrator should use the Q value and provide an ID change record with the Retention submission so that the student is properly tracked.

--(2.2) The Retention software might correctly assign a student into two different cohort types, but the institution submits a cohort change record to change the cohort type for one of the records which might violate the rule that a student cannot have the same cohort type for different cohort years. When this happens the institution would apply the Q value to the later cohort year record to remove the duplicate record.

The 'Q' value should <u>not</u> be used when:

 A student may be correctly reported in multiple cohorts as different cohort types at the same institution. Some examples include: an FTIC who drops out and is subsequently officially re-admitted to your institution as an FCS AA transfer student, or a (U) transfer student drops out of your institution and is subsequently officially re-admitted to your institution as an FCS AA transfer student.
 A student may be correctly reported in multiple FTIC cohorts at different institutions, if the student was admitted as an FTIC at two institutions in the 'same' term. Note: Because of the Student Right to Know rules, this would include a student who begins at your institution in either the summer or fall term and at another institution in the similar summer/fall term.

(3) An FTIC student at your institution is found to have been admitted to another institution before they were enrolled as a degree-seeking student at your institution, and the student had earned more than 11 credits since high school graduation. This student should be reclassified into a transfer cohort which would require using the 'Information Adjusted by Correction' value (COHORT_ADJ_IND='I') and not the Q value.
