Physical media, and digital books, media and serials all reflect significant differences reported by the recently migrated integrated library system (Primo/Alma). In spite of running multiple reports and cross checking with Acquisitions staff, and working with the consortial system managers, we see shifts in how the items have been counted. The use of the new ILS makes it easier to add open educational resources & open access ebooks. Prior reporting relied upon collecting data from numerous vendors but the new Alma platform consolidates all of this information. But last year, the Standalone ebooks - those not included in a particular collection, were not reported. Therefore, we have increased significantly our
